Dear Colleague,

We have used the IG 2000 in our 7 doctor mixed animal practice since February 2001. It has become an integrated part of our practice for relief of pain and inflammation associated with degenerative joint disease, neoplasia and surgery, wound healing associated with trauma or surgery, and eye ulcers for a few examples. We have found that it is a great adjunctive therapy in conjunction with traditional medications and treatments. It can also stand alone in those cases where the patient is intolerant of oral medications.

Our IG2000 unit has held up to travel, use in barn environments etc. We feel it has advantages over other therapeutic units because its energy can be absorbed. The penetration depth is irrelevant. We use it almost daily for large and small animal patients. In the past 12 months, over \$9,000 was invoiced for treatments. This does not include associated fees like trip charges, exams or instances where the treatment fee was rolled into a procedure.

Overall it has been a great addition to our practice. It works well in our multi-modal approach to pain management. It has been well received by our clientele and has given us an opportunity to generate new clientele as well.
